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1. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1.1. Introduction

The Chairman, Departmental Procurement Committee (DPC), invites sealed bids to provide Insurance Covers to **Ceylon Petroleum Corporation** (**CPC**) for a period of One Year, commencing from 12.09.2024 for Motor Vehicle Fleet Insurance Cover as per General Terms and Conditions and annexed schedules.

1.2. Eligibility criteria

In order to be considered as eligible for bidding, a Bidder must:

- 1.2.1. Be a valid registered entity at Insurance Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka (IRCSL).
- 1.2.2. Be an established insurance Company in active operations within Sri Lanka for at least last five years.
- 1.2.3. Gross premium on general insurance should not be less than LKR two billion either in
- **1.2.4.** Financial year 2021 or 2022 or 2023.
- 1.2.5. Should have more than 5 years' experience in the large scale (100 or above) fleet Insurance experience in Sri Lanka.

1.3. Scope of Insurance Covers

Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC) invites bids for providing the services related to Vehicle Insurance Covers from eligible, reputed Insurance Service Providers who are registered under the Insurance Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka (IRCSL) and qualified under criteria as specified here in this document, for a period of twelve (12) months commencing 12.09.2024 for the followings:

(Failure to furnish the above said documents and details, before the closing of bid, may result in the bid being rejected. All documents shall be furnished in English language.)

1.5.2. Additional Requirements to be fulfilled by the Insurance agent/broker

1.5.2.1. Bids from the registered agent/broker representing Insurance Company should acompany a Letter of Authorization from the Insurance Company, empowering the authorized agent/broker to bid on behalf of them and to fulfil all the terms and conditions of the contract, in the event of the bid being awarded.

Format of Letter of Authorization - Annexure "G" is attached.

1.5.2.2. All documents relevant to the insurance companies (insurers) & other institutions as specified under 1.5.1 relevant & specific to the bid

1.5.3. Additional Requirements to be fulfilled by the Insurance broker

If the Bidder is an insurance broker, in addition to all the requirements enumerated in the Bid Document, the following shall be fulfilled and submitted along with the bid.

- 1.5.3.1. Brokers should bid only on behalf of insurance companies registered with IRCSL which meets with the criteria mentioned in the bid document. It is also a condition that, the bid should be in a manner it enables CPC to deal & enter into contract direct with the insurer.
- 1.5.3.2. Be a valid registered insurance broker at Insurance Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka (IRCSL)
- 1.5.3.3. Be an established Insurance Broker in active operations within Sri Lanka for at least last five years and has not been suspended/license cancelled during last five years.

1.6. Sealing & Marking of the Bid

Bids shall be submitted in duplicates as per the conditions specified in this bidding document. The original and the duplicate of the bid should be placed in separate envelopes marked "ORIGINAL" and "DUPLICATE". Both envelopes should be enclosed in one securely sealed cover, which should be marked "BID FOR THE INSURANCE COVERS FOR MOTOR VEHECLE FLEET OF CPC FOR THE YEAR 2024/2025" on the top left hand corner and the statement, "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE 1400 hrs. on 31.07.2024 and shall be addressed to:

If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as required above, the DPC will assume no responsibility for the bid being misplaced or premature opening. If the outer envelope discloses the bidder's identity, the DPC will not guarantee anonymity of the bid submission but this disclosure will not constitute grounds for bid rejection.

1.7. Period of Validity of the Bid

The Bid shall be valid for a minimum period of Sixty Three (63) days (i.e. up to 02.10.2024) from the closing date of the Bid. The bidder should indicate the maximum period that their Bids would be valid.

1.8. Bid Security Guarantee

a) Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security, undertaking that the Bid will be held valid for the specified period, and that the Bid will not be withdrawn during that period. Such security shall be in the form of a Bank Guarantee issued by a Licensed Commercial Bank in Sri Lanka and approved by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka, payable to the CPC on demand in a sum of Rupees Fifty Thousand only (Rs 50,000.00).

b) The Bid Security shall be valid for Ninety One (91) days (i.e. up to 30.10.2024) days from the date of the closing of bid. A format of Bid Security is attached as Annexure

"B".

c) Failure to submit the Bid Security at the time, or before the closing of Bid, and in

accordance with above said requirements, and in the format provided, will result in the

Bid being rejected.

d) Bid Security from unsuccessful Bidders will be returned to them after the award is

made to the successful Bidder. The Bid Security of the successful Bidder will be

returned only after receipt of the Insurance Policy.

1.9. Format and Signing of the Bid

a) The bidder shall prepare an original and a duplicate of the Bid specified above, clearly marked

as "BID FOR THE INSURANCE COVERS FOR MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET OF CPC

FOR THE YEAR 2024/2025" original and duplicate as appropriate. In the event of any

discrepancy between the original and duplicate, the original shall govern.

b) The original and the duplicate of the Bid shall be typed, or written in indelible ink, and shall

be signed by the bidder, or person(s) duly authorized to bind the bidder to the contract. All

pages of the Bid except for un-amended printed matter shall be initialed by the person(s)

signing the Bid.

c) Any inter lineation, erasures or over-writing shall be valid only if they are initialed by the

person(s) signing the Bid.

1.11. Deadline for submission of Bids

- a) Chairman, DPC, must receive bids at the address, time & date specified under ITB clause 1.11
- b) Chairman, DPC, may, at the discretion, extend the deadline for submission of Bids, by amending the bid documents, in which case all rights and obligations of CPC and the Bidder will thereafter be subjected to the deadline as extended.

1.12. Late Bids

Any Bid received by the Chairman – DPC, after the deadline for submission of Bids, will be rejected and returned unopened to Bidder. Postal or other delays will not be considered as valid reasons for acceptance of late Bids.

1.13. Modification & Withdrawal of the Bid

- a) The Bidder may modify or withdraw his Bid after submission, provided that written notice of the modification or withdrawal is received by the Chairman, DPC, prior to the closing time prescribed for Bid Submission. The Bidder's modifications shall be prepared, sealed, marked and dispatched as follows:
- b) Bidder's shall provide an original and a duplicate, as specified in the ITB clause 1.7 of any modifications to his Bid, clearly identified as such in two envelopes, duly marked "BID FOR THE INSURANCE COVERS FOR MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET OF CPC FOR THE YEAR 2024/2025". The envelopes shall be sealed in an outer envelope, duly marked "MODIFICATIONS TO THE BID- Insurance Covers for Motor Vehicle Fleet of CPC or the year 2024/2025".
- c) Bidder wishing to withdraw his Bid, shall notify the DPC in writing prior to the deadline prescribed for the submission of the Bid. A withdrawal notice may also be sent by Facsimile, but must be followed by the original, by post or by hand to reach the CPC not later than the deadline for submission of Bid. not later than 1400 hrs. Sri Lanka local time on 31.07.2024. If the Bidder or their representatives choose not to send their bids under registered Cover, they could deposit such bids in the Tender Box provided for this purpose at the office of the above address.

1.15. Opening of Bids by CPC

- a) The Bids will be opened immediately after the closing date and time fixed for receipt of bids, at the office of above address or such other place as arranged if the office of the Manager (Procurement & Stores) is not available.
- b) The Chairman, DPC or his nominated representative will open the Bid in the presence of the representatives the Bidder, who choose to attend the bid opening at the time, the date and at the opening place specified in the Invitation to Bid. Representatives of Bidders shall sign a register as proof of their attendance.
- c) The Bid prices, discounts, and bidders' names, the presence or absence of the requisite Bid Security, will be announced at the opening. Late bids will not be entertained and will be returned unopened to the bidder.

1.16. Insurance Cover Bid Forms

a) Bidder is required to duly sign and return the Insurance Cover Bid Forms indicating their bids in detail.

b) Prices not submitted on the prescribed form and in the manner required are liable for rejection.

1.17. Preliminary Examination of Bids

- a) The DPC will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, any computational errors have been made, whether the documents have been properly signed, and the bids are generally in order. The DPC may, at its discretion call clarifications from in writing.
- b) The response shall be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the Bid shall be sought, Bided or permitted.

1.18. Correction of Errors

- a) The Bid determined to be substantially responsive will be checked for any arithmetical error and errors will be corrected in the following manner.
- b) Where the discrepancy is between the amount in figures and the amount in words, the amount in words will prevail.
- c) Where the discrepancy is between unit rate and the line total, resulting from multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted will govern, unless in the opinion of the Chairman, DPC, there is an obvious gross misplacement of the decimal point in the rate in which case the line item total as quoted will govern, and the unit rate will be corrected.
- d) The amount stated in the Form of Bid adjusted in accordance with the above procedure with the concurrence of the Bidder shall be considered as binding upon the Bidder. If the Bidder does not accept the correct amount of bid, the bid shall be rejected.

1.19. Evaluation Criteria

The DPC will carry out a detailed evaluation of the bids to determine whether the technical aspects are properly addressed, and the Bids are substantially responsive based on the following.

- a) Eligibility, Financial position and the technical capability of the insurance provider
- b) Lowest acceptable premium quoted within conditions given in the Insurance Cover Bids forms.

All offers received will be examined to determine the eligibility of bidder's responded and substantial responsiveness of bids received. Only the bids determined to be substantially

responsive will be evaluated and compared. Award will be made to the lowest evaluated substantial responsive bid. Incomplete bids will be rejected.

1.20. Right to accept or reject any or all Bids

The DPC will not be bound to make the award to the bidder submitting the lowest bid. The DPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof without assessing any reasons.

1.21. Awarding criteria

- a) On a Bid thereof being accepted, CPC will notify such acceptance to the bidder in the form of a letter of award to the address given by him whose bid thereof has been accepted.
- b) Upon such notification the successful bidder shall be deemed to have entered into contract with the CPC in the performance of the services for which his bid was accepted, on the basis of his bid and he shall there upon be deemed to be the contractor for the performance of the intended services.
- c) Contract Agreement The successful bidder would be called upon to enter into an agreement with CPC after awarding the Tender. The contract agreement shall be signed within seven (07) days from the date of Letter of Acceptance. A specimen of Contract Agreement is attached in Annexure "F". In case, the successful bidder MPC accepts the bid of registered agent/broker as per the evaluation criteria in the ITB 1.19, the contract agreement shall be signed by registered Insurance Company
- d) If the successful contractor fails to enter into a formal contract with CPC within seven (7) days of notice as indicated above, his name will be placed on the list of defaulting contractors and the CPC shall forthwith be entitled in its absolute discretion to make with such other party as it may think fit (whether with another bidder or not) at the risk and expense of the successful bidder, the arrangements required for the execution of the Contract for which the successful bidder's Bid shall have been accepted and shall be further entitled to recover from the successful bidder all losses, costs, damages and expenses which the CPC may sustain in consequence of such failure. The Bidder shall be liable for forfeiture of the Bid Security furnished by him along with the bid at the time of bidding.

1.22. Acceptance of the Bid

a) Notice of acceptance of the bid will be sent to the successful bidder/bidders by facsimile followed by registered post in the form of a letter of award to the address given by him in the Bid.

- b) If there is a change in the Bidder's address, the bidder shall forthwith notify the Chairman DPC, Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC), Procurement & Stores Function, 01st Floor, No 609, Dr. Canister De Silva Mw. Colombo 9 of such change.
- c) The DPC reserves the right to split the award among several bidders or to award to one bidder or to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason. In the event the DPC rejects all Bid submitted, the DPC reserves the right to call for fresh Bids.

2. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE BID

2.1 Scope of Contract

The scope of insurance to be provided shall include following policies,

- 1. Motor Comprehensive (Full Insurance) Private Car Fleet 42
- Motor Comprehensive (Full Insurance) Commercial Lorries & Special Type
 Vehicles 39
- 3. Motor Comprehensive (Full Insurance) Motor Cycle Fleet 16
- 4. Motor Comprehensive (Full Insurance) Commercial Buses 05
- 5. Motor Comprehensive (Full Insurance) Commercial Duel Purposes Vehicles 39
- 6. Motor third Party Special Type Vehicles 27

The insurance company shall provide insurance covers for all the policies in full for one-year period.

2.2 Execution of Contract

The finalized insurance policies shall be fully effective once the contract is awarded and signed the agreement. The selected insurance company shall comply the following requirements.

- 1) CPC reserves the right to attend to the accident repairs by CPC owned garage, local agent or any other place as decided by the management.
- 2) The claims lodged shall be honored within the contract period and even after the expiration of contract period.
- 3) CPC reserves the right to recover any losses incurred from the performance security in the event the insurance company defaults in execution of contract.

2.3 Performance Security

The successful bidder is required to provide a performance security to safeguard the CPC against nonperformance of the contract. The successful bidder, on being notified by CPC of the acceptance of his bid, shall furnish at his own expense a performance security, in one of following forms within fourteen (14) days of such notification. Such performance security shall be,

- a) in the form of a bank guarantee issued by a licensed commercial bank operating in Sri Lanka, or
- b) in the form of a cash deposit to the CPC Cashier for a minimum sum equivalent to 10% of the total Contract value (inclusive of taxes) of the accepted bid in Sri Lankan Rupees (LKR).

The bank in Sri Lanka shall be a valid approved commercial bank with the authority of a license issued by the Monitory Board. (Central Bank of Sri Lanka)

In case of a bank guarantee, it shall be furnished without a substantial departure to the format given in Annexure C

If the successful bidder fails to furnish the performance security as aforesaid, his name shall be placed in the list of defaulting bidders. CPC, shall therefore, be entitled in its absolute discretion to make suitable arrangements required for the performance of such bid, at the risk & expense of the successful bidder.

The successful bidder, in the event of his failure to furnish the performance security as required, shall be liable for any losses, costs, expenses & damages, which CPC may sustain in consequence of such failure and the bid security, shall be forfeited.

Official Purchase Order shall be released only after the receipt of the performance security. The performance security shall be in favor of CPC and shall be unconditionally en-cashable on demand by CPC and shall be valid for a period Fourteen (14) months from date of the confirmation of award In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the period of validity of the performance security, CPC may request to extend the period of validity for a specified additional period, in order to meet the delivery schedule.

2.4 Mode of Payment

Total premium shall be paid in Sri Lankan Rupees within 60 days, and successful activation of insurance policy in line with CPC requirements.

2.5 Defaults by Successful Bidder

If for any reason, in the opinion of CPC, the successful bidder becomes incapable or unable to provide the service offered in his bid, CPC shall have the right to obtain such service from other sources without being liable in any manner whatsoever, to the successful bidder.

If the successful bidder, defaults in the service or otherwise commits a breach of any of the provisions in the contract with CPC, for the service according to the specifications, he shall be liable to pay CPC, all losses, damages and expenses incurred by CPC, in consequence of such default or breach.

The contractor in these circumstances shall also render himself liable to be placed in the list of defaulting bidders and be precluded from having any concern in CPC tenders.

2.6 Disputes

Any dispute of whatever nature arising from, out of or in connection with this agreement, on the interpretation thereof, or the rights, duties, obligations or liabilities of any party, or the operation,

breach, termination, abandonment, foreclosure or invalidity thereof, shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of law governing like disputes and triable by court of law of The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

2.7 Special Conditions:

- 2. The following documents shall constitute the Contract between the CPC and the Service Provider and each shall be read and construed as an integral part of the Contract:

 - Duly filled Form of bid

 - Letter of Acceptance by bidder
- 3. This Contract shall prevail over all other Contract documents. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency within the Contract documents, then the documents shall prevail in the order listed above.
