### INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION (EOI) TO BUILT, OPERATE AND TRANSFER (BOT) OF A MAINTENANCE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE VESSEL (MERV)

This is with reference to the paper advertisement appeared in newspapers on 09.05.2018 for the purchase of a MERV on BOT basis.

All the interested applicant are informed that the paper advertisement has been amended as indicated below.

Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC) on behalf of the Cabinet Appointed Procurement Committee (CAPC) invites Expression of Interest from reputed and experienced Parties (Firms/Join Ventures) to indicate their interest in providing a Maintenance and Emergency Response Vessel (MREV) on Built, Operate and Transfer basis for CPC.

#### **Back ground : -**

1. The Ceylon petroleum Corporation (CPC) , Ministry of Petroleum Resources Development , the Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka (the “**Authority**”) has been serving the nation by supplying fuel for local transportation and power generation. CPC has a Refinery at Sapugaskanda which is able to supply the 30% of total fuel demand of the country and the balance 70% demand is catered by importing refined products. There are three fuel unloading locations for unloading fuel imported to Sri Lanka.
  1. SPBM located at 9.2Km away from Colombo port to unload Crude Oil.
  2. SPBM located at 6km away from Muthurajawela to unload Refined Petroleum Products
  3. Dolphin Tanker berth located at Colombo port having facility to unload with Crude Oil and Refined Products.
2. It is a requirement to have a Maintenance and Emergency Response Vessel (MERV) for the operations maintenance and emergency activities of Two SPBMs. From the year 1987, CPC has being chartering a MERV for the said task and now the authority has decided to procure a Vessel through a private party on Build, Operate and Transfer ( "**BOT**") basis , and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity for this procurement.

Minimum requirements of the expected Vessel are :

- a) Length (overall) : thirty five meters (35m)
- b) Breadth (moulded) : ten meters (10m).
- c) Depth (moulded) : four meters (4m).

- d) Length between the main winch and stern : fifteen (15) meters.
- (e) Twin screw, controllable pitch propulsion system (CPP) with main engines : Developing a total BHP of 3000 (Three Thousand) continuous rating.
- (f) The vessel's continuous static bollard pull : 60 Metric Tons (MT).
- (g) Bow thruster developing : 3.7 MT of thrust at continuous rating

The Authority intends to pre-qualify suitable Applicants (the “**Bidders**”) who will be eligible for participation in the Bid Stage, for awarding the Project.

The scope of work of this contract will include designing, building, financing, operation and maintenance of the MERV including vessel's crew management until the ownership is transferred to CPC.

The EOI Documents will be issued free of charge to the Applicant during working days from **0900 hrs to 1500 hrs Sri Lanka time till 18/07/2018**. The bidders can inspect the above EOI document at CPC website [www.ceypetco.gov.lk](http://www.ceypetco.gov.lk)
