INVITATION FOR BIDS

Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (Ministry of Energy) Site Clearing, Levelling, and Compaction Works for 8-Acre Land at Muthurajawela B/60/2025

- 1. The Chairman Department Procurement Committee (DPC) on behalf of the Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC) invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Site Clearing, Leveling, and Compaction Works for 8-Acre Land at Muthurajawela as described below.
 - CPC has an approximately eight (08) acres of land at Muthurajawela. The work under this contract shall include the complete clearing of those 08 acres land by removing all trees, bushes, shrubs, grass, roots, stumps, and any other vegetation or organic material in order to make the land completely bare. All removed materials shall be collected, transported to a pre-determined location of the Contractor without keeping those materials inside the CPC premises. After clearing, the contractor shall carry out necessary filling, leveling, grading, and compaction to form a clean, smooth, and stable surface in accordance with the Engineer's instructions, ensuring the entire land area is properly prepared for future development activities. Duration of the contract is 02 months.
- 2. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedure.
- 3. To be eligible for contract award, the successful bidder shall not have been blacklisted and shall meet the CIDA registration C9.
- 4. Qualification requirements to qualify for contract award include that the Bidder should have carried out previous contracts of similar nature land clearing / land levelling contracts at least having contract values of Rs. 3,000,000.00 for past 03 years (2024,2023,2022) and shall be able to maintain a positive cash flow record throughout the contract period.

- 6. Section – 6 SPECIFICATIONS

Specifications (Scope of Works)

6.1 General

The work under this contract includes all labour, materials, tools, plant, and equipment necessary to complete the clearing, leveling, and compaction of approximately eight (08) acres of land situated at Muthurajawela. The purpose of this work is to prepare the site as a bare, level, and compacted area suitable for future development activities as directed by the Engineer. All operations shall be executed in accordance with this Scope of Work, the Specifications, and the Engineer's instructions.

6.2 Location of the Site

The project site is located within the CPC-owned land area at Muthurajawela. The site consists of approximately eight (08) acres of land covered with dense vegetation, including trees, shrubs, and undergrowth, and generally lies on soft to medium soil. The area may include low-lying and uneven ground conditions typical of the Muthurajawela region.

6.3 Description of Works

The major components of the works include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following:

A. Site Clearing

- Cut, remove, and dispose of all vegetation, including trees, bushes, shrubs, grass, and weeds.
- Remove all roots, stumps, and other organic matter and remaining concrete foundation portions.
- Collect and transport all removed materials to a suitable location outside the CPC premises, identified by the Contractor, for the proper disposal of debris, demolished concrete, and other waste materials.

B. Grading and Earthwork

• Level and dress the entire land surface to a flat land.

C. Compaction

- Compact the prepared ground using suitable compaction equipment (roller or vibro compactor).
- The compacted surface shall be firm, stable, and free from irregularities, soft spots, or standing water.

D. Final Dressing

- Trim and finish the entire area to present a clean, uniform, and even surface ready for future construction activities.
- Remove all temporary heaps, debris, and waste materials from the site.

6.4 Disposal of Materials

All vegetation, organic soil, tree trunks, branches, and other waste materials generated during the clearing and grubbing process shall be removed from the site and disposed of at a location approved by the Engineer. No burning or open dumping will be permitted within or near the project boundary.

6.5 Equipment and Methods

The Contractor shall employ suitable machinery and methods for efficient execution of the works, including but not limited to:

- Hydraulic excavators, dozers, and loaders for clearing and leveling
- Tippers or dump trucks for transporting debris and soil
- Rollers or compactors for compaction
- Chainsaws or mechanical cutters for tree felling and stump removal

All equipment shall be in good working condition and operated by competent personnel.

6.5 Environmental and Safety Requirements

The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to minimize environmental disturbance during the works, including:

- Prevention of dust generation and soil erosion
- Safe handling and transportation of debris
- Avoidance of contamination to nearby waterways or marsh areas
- Ensuring worker safety through the use of PPE and adherence to applicable safety regulations

The Contractor shall comply with all instructions issued by the Engineer or relevant authorities regarding environmental protection and occupational health and safety.
